The Elwood Public Library Board held its regular meeting, July 5, 1960 at 7:00 P.M. Those present were; Mrs. Powell, Sharp and Wellnitz; Mr. Allen, Hadley and Shickley. Mrs. Hunt the librarian was also present.

The minutes of the last meeting were approved as read. Mrs. Hunt read the Librarian's report; it was approved. The financial report was read stating that the Library received from the tax draw \$15, 713.05. After expenditures of \$2655.73 we have a balance Of \$16,943.23 as of June 30.1960.

The furniture for the staff room was purchased and delivered. The staff is very well pleased with the room.

Mrs. Hunt said that we will have about \$1900 left this year and that we need new shelving badly. Mrs. Hunt is going to call the light company and have their engineer come over to the library and plan for new lighting for the building and give us an estimate on the cost. It was also decided to buy a new clock for the childrens room.

The Elwood Public Library Board held its monthly meeting Wed., Nov. 2, 1960. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as read. The rinancial report stating that \$2,020.12 had been spent during the month of October and that we have a balance on hand of \$8,928.92 was read and accepted.

Mrs. Hunt, the Librarian reported the addition of 151 new books to the shelves to make a total of 28,629 in the book collection. The total circulation of books is 5794. There were 233 new horrowers registered to use the library during Oct.. 264 information questions answered by the library staff including 33 questions by telephone.
