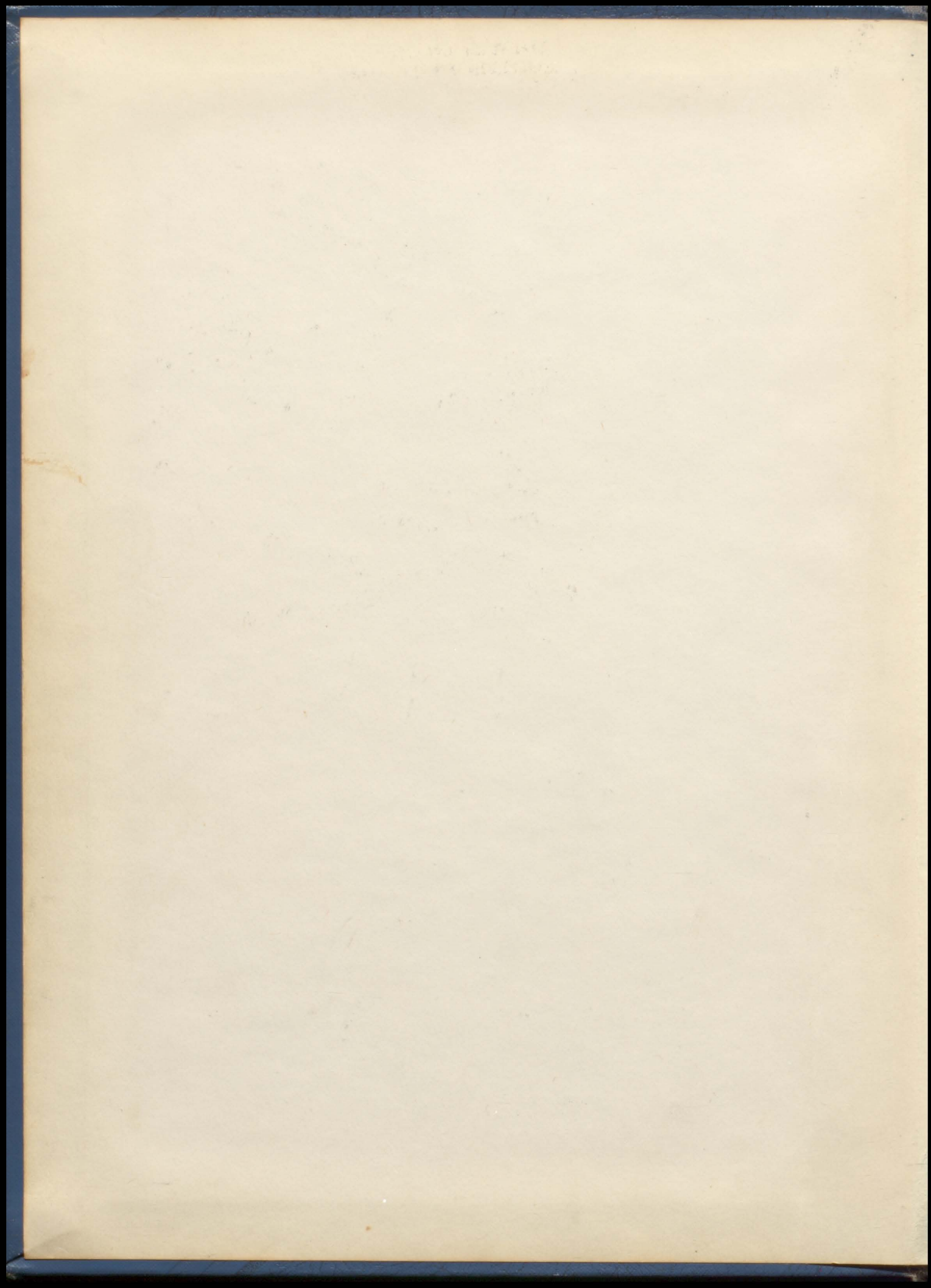



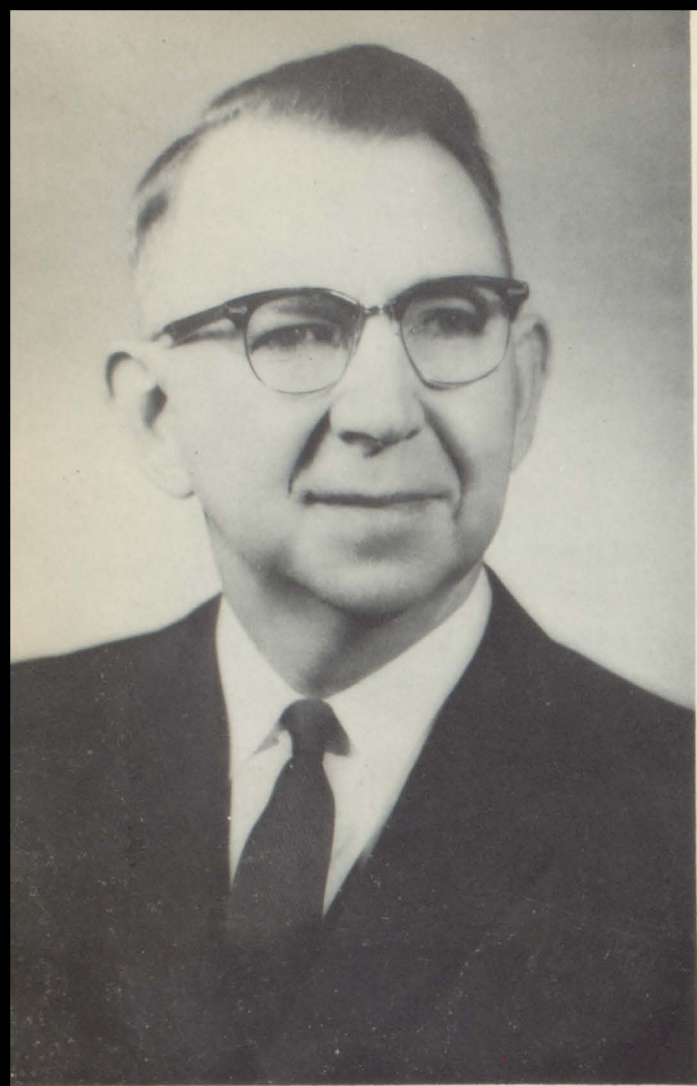

Dedication

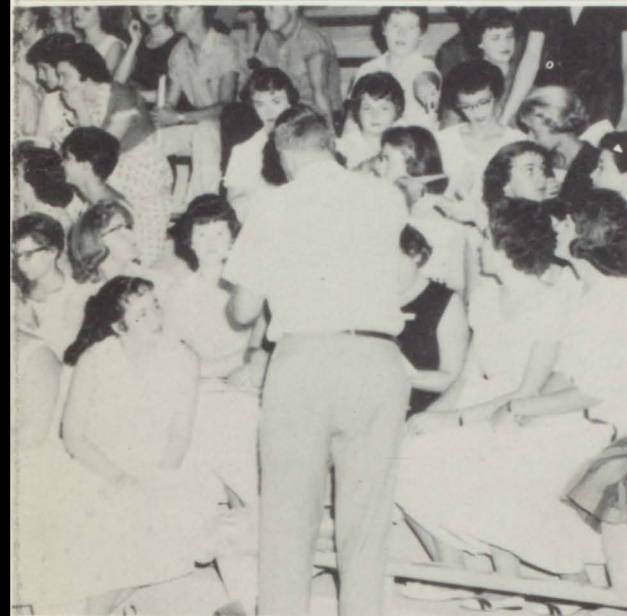
Serving Pipecreek Township as trustees for 18 years, Waldo and Millicent Canaday have endeared themselves to the hearts of both students and patrons of the school.

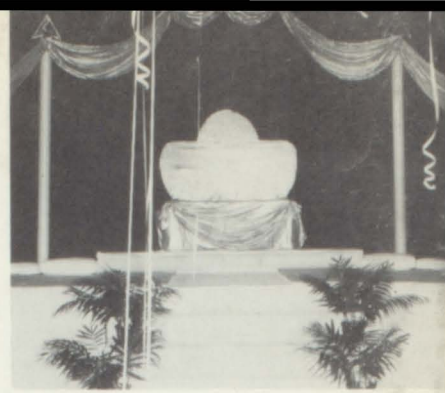

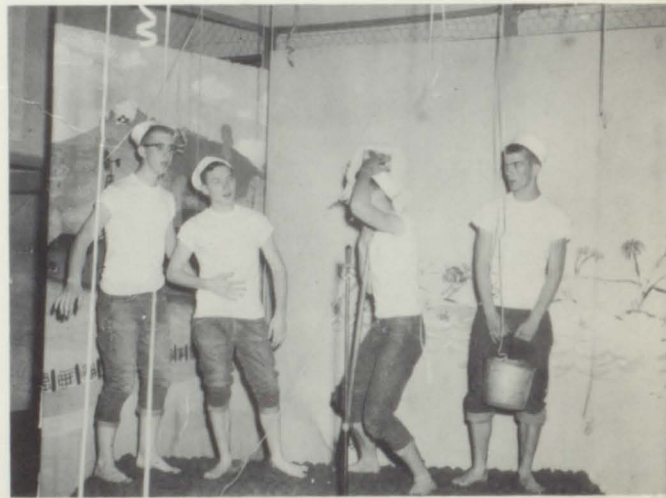

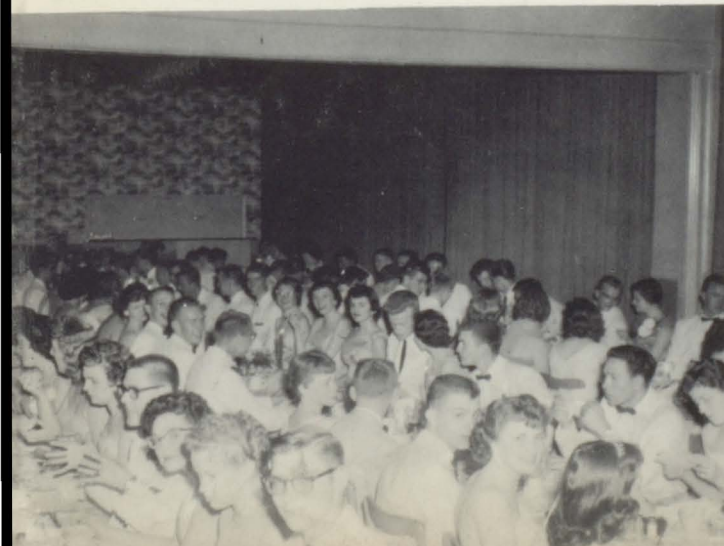

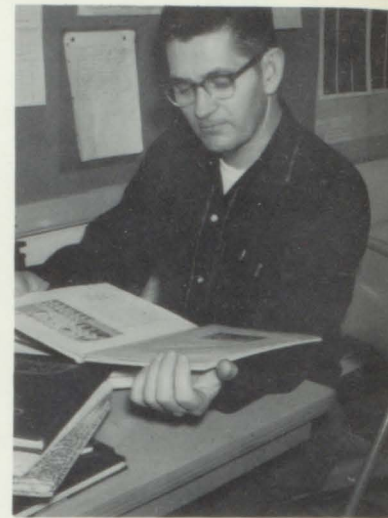

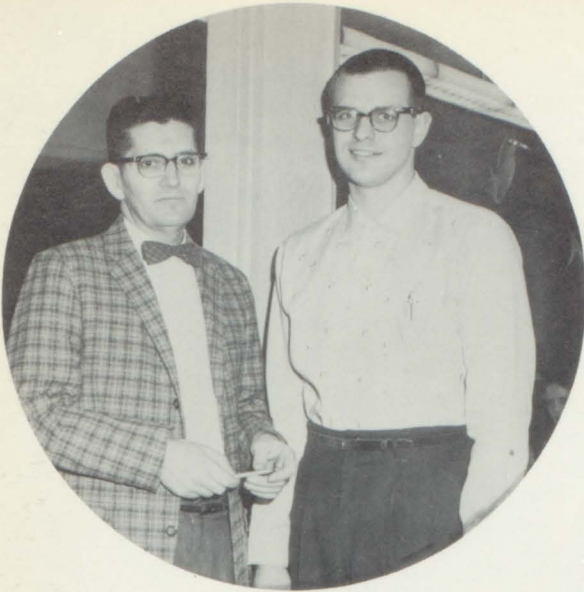

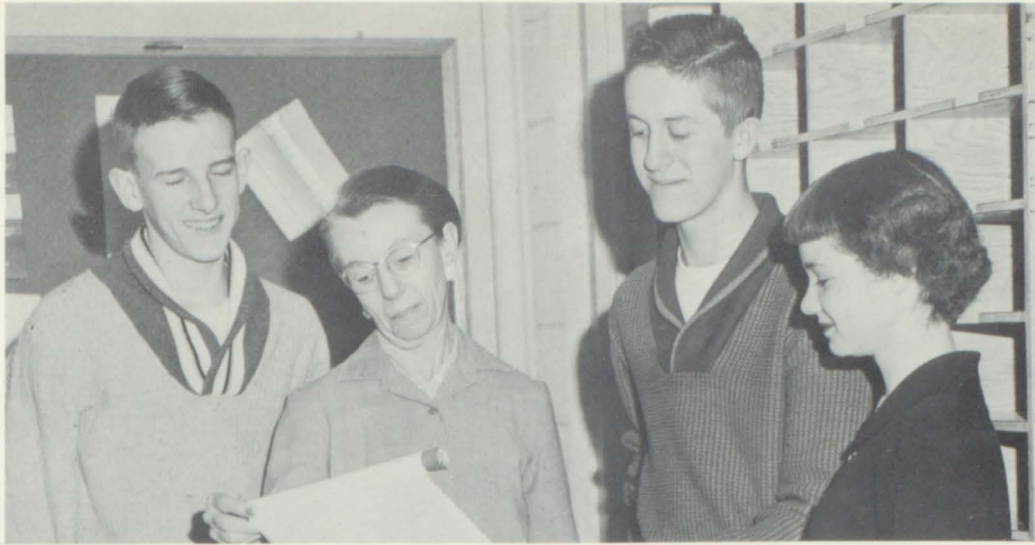

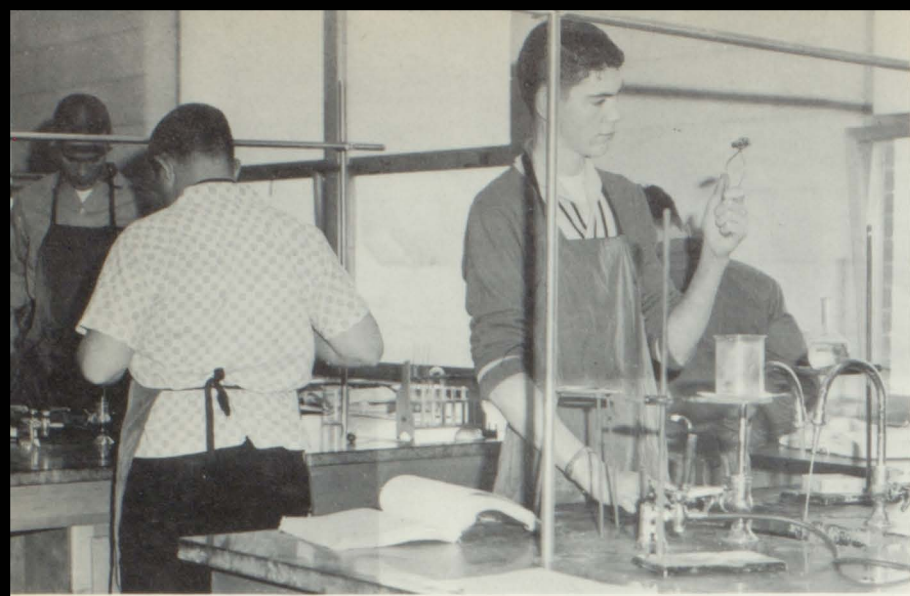

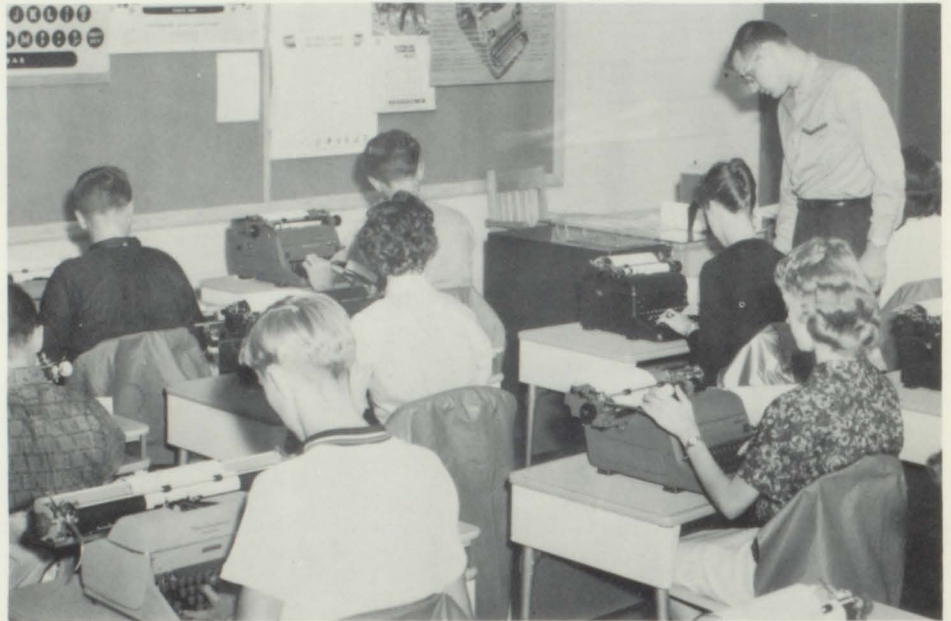

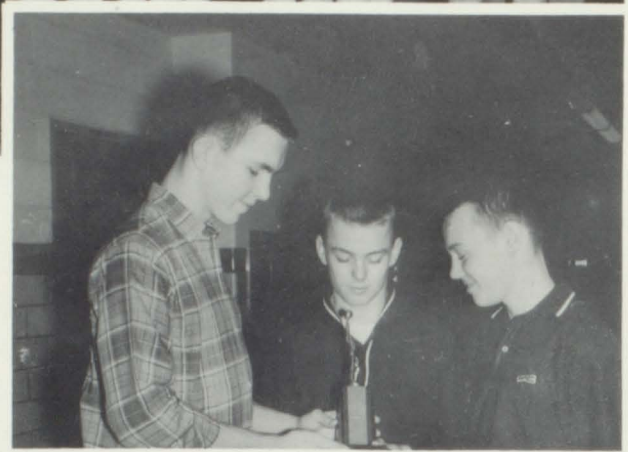
