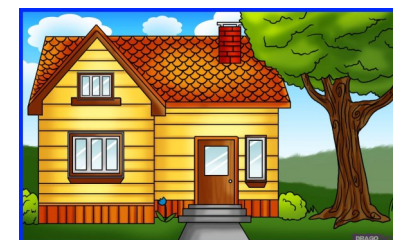

We can deliver books, movies, magazines and audio books right to your home. Here are just a few examples you can choose from:

How Do I Know I Will Get Materials That I Enjoy?

Before bringing material to your home a member of the library staff will call to schedule a home or phone interview. At our first meeting we will discuss areas of interest which will help us better understand what types of authors and books you prefer and other information that may be helpful.

When Can I Expect Delivery?

Deliveries are made by library staff on the first Friday of each month. We will call you the day before a delivery to remind you to expect your books the following day.

How Long May I Borrow The Items I Take Out?

The lending period for all items through the Homebound program is 4 weeks. You can renew your books once, as long as no other patrons are waiting for them.
